

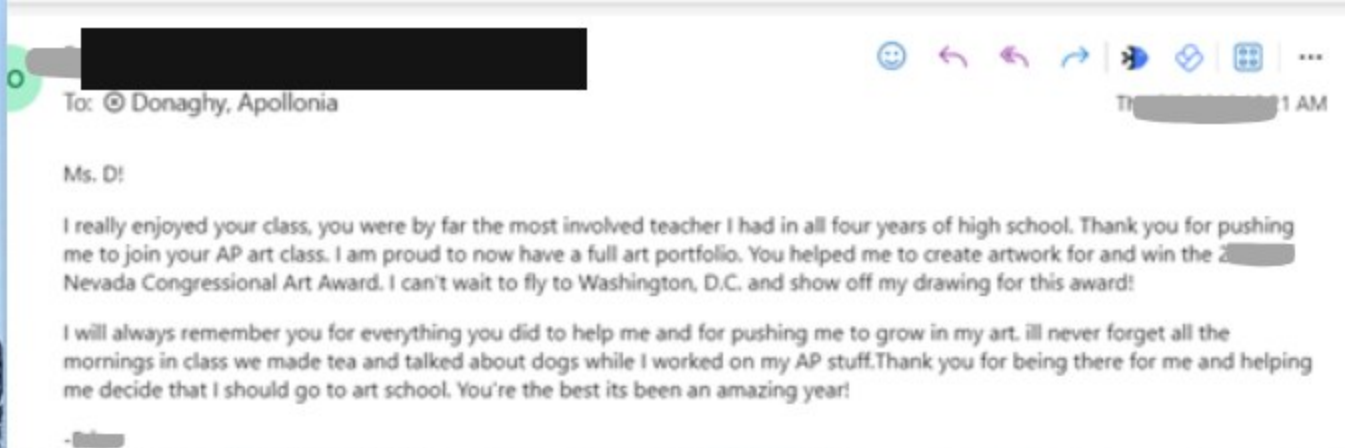

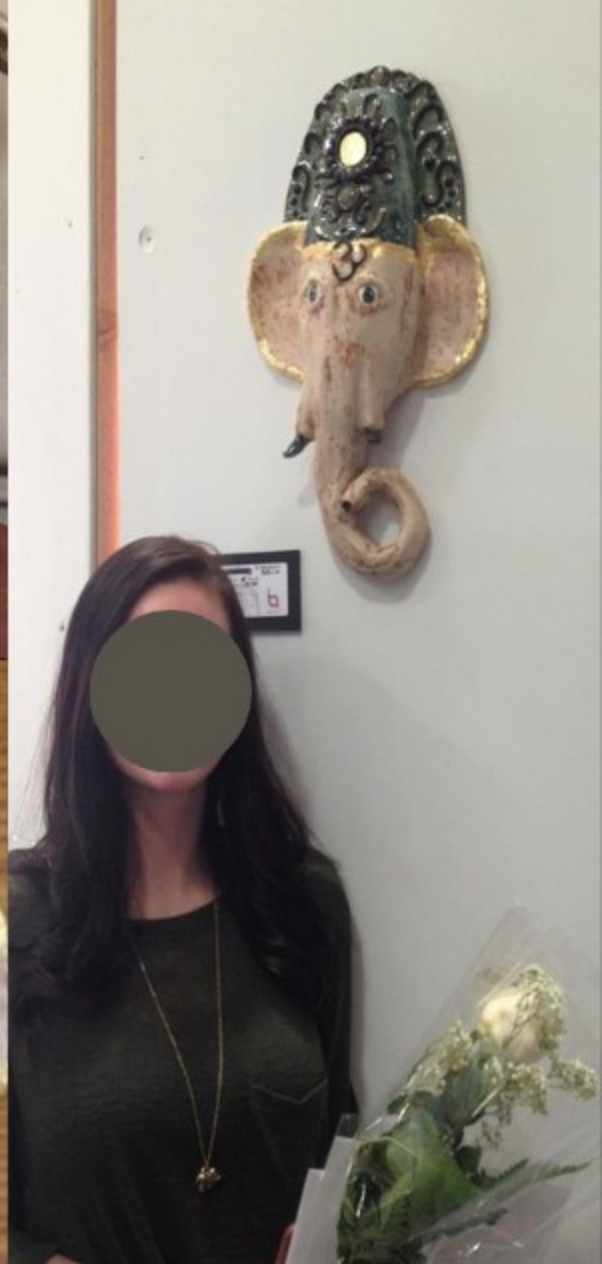

"Tribal Wolf Mask", by Perrow Willard was featured in the Uni County High Schools joint art show held by Artouch, a local organization.

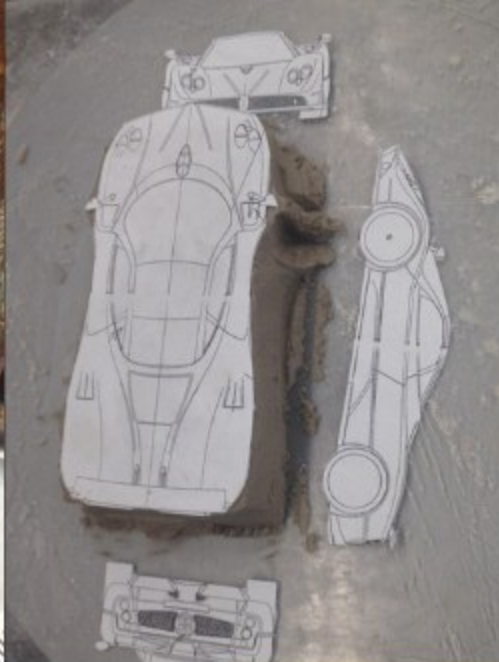

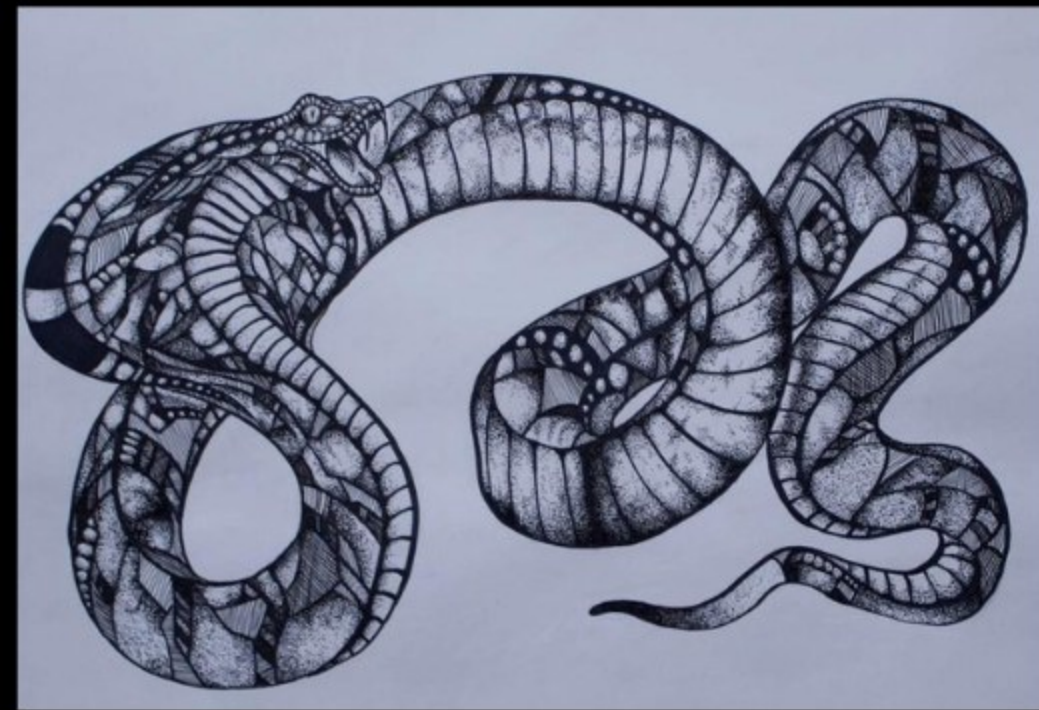
Poem collaboration with English Language Arts.
